BYELAWS

with respect to the
control of dogs
in cemeteries

BYELAWS

made under Section 213 and paragraph 11 of Schedule 26 of the Local Government Act, 1972 by the by the District Council of Shepway with respect to the Control of Dogs in Cemeteries.

- (1) No person being in charge of a dog shall cause or suffer the dog to enter or remain in any of the cemeteries specified in Schedule 1 to these Byelaws unless such dog is carried or led by a strap or chain or is otherwise prevented from running at large and effectively restrained.
- (2) For the purpose of this Byelaw the owner of the dog shall be deemed to be in charge thereof, unless the Court is satisfied that at the time when the Byelaw was broken the dog had been placed in or taken into the charge of some other person.
- (3) Any person offending against this Byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £20.
